JUNIOR Second Referee – 2009

Requirements:

- 1. Attend a GEVA clinic. The average length of the R-2 clinic is 90 minutes. All of the information covered is contained in USAV rulebook. Reading the rulebook in advance of the clinic is not required, as all necessary information will be covered in detail at the clinic.
- 2. At the end of the clinic, candidates will take a written test covering the rules and techniques of the R-2. The passing grade is 80%.
- 3. The candidate will then officiate as R-2 at GEVA sanctioned events, with USAV certified First Referees, who hold a Provisional or higher rating, under actual match conditions. The candidate must submit two passing rating cards.
- 4. Passing rating cards will be returned to the R-2. Their Coach or Club Director will forward them to the Junior R-2 Coordinator at the following address:

- 5. The Club Director will be notified of the certification of the candidate by the Junior R-2 Coordinator.
- 6. If a candidate becomes certified, the next season, attendance at a clinic is not required, but they must submit one passing rating card to renew their certification. The following season, they must attend a clinic, pass the written test and submit one passing rating card to renew their certification.

All certified R-2's will be monitored at GEVA tournaments to assure that acceptable performances are maintained even after receiving certification.
